# PLAY FLAG FOOTBALL!

The Edmonton Eskimos along with Football Alberta are proud to offer The Eskimo's Novice and Atom Flag Football League for kids aged 6-11.

## PROGRAM DETAILS for 2014

- Flag Football League for Novice (born 2006, 2007, & 2008) and Atom (born 2004 & 2005) kids broken up into Open and Girls Only categories.
- Team of 8 players that will play 5 on 5 Flag Football
- All games played indoors at Commonwealth Stadium Community Fieldhouse with possibly some outdoor venues used as well.
- The season runs from first weekend after Labor Day in September until the first weekend in November
- Teams get one practice/game session a week on Sunday for 90 minutes.
- Players are evaluated on the first day and placed on teams according to ability
- At both Novice and Atom there will be four divisions of play based on ability levels and gender
- All teams are named after current CFL teams
- The Edmonton Eskimo players drop by at least four times a year to lend their support to the program.
- No experience necessary. This is entry level football for players from both genders.
- The University of Alberta Golden Bear Football Team will be providing coaches for the Novice level team but parents are more than welcome to indicate their willingness to help out as an Assistant Coach or Manager via the registration process.
- The Atom level teams will require Parents to sign up as Head and/or Assistant Coaches and Managers.
- All Coaches will be given a seminar and "how to" book to assist them in getting into the Flag game.

# Backyard Play Safety

With summer approaching, Alberta Health Services EMS would like to encourage parents to ensure their backyard play areas are made safe. Direct supervision is the best method to reduce the chance of injury. It is also prudent to ensure play equipment in your yard is suitable for the age and skill of the children using it. Don't forget to check the equipment often, and repair any worn or broken parts. Set up play equipment on a shock-absorbing surface such as sand, wood chips, or pea gravel. Grass may not adequately cushion a fall.

### Water hazards

- Ensure all backyard swimming pools are fenced. The fence should be at least 1.5 metres (5 feet) high and have a self-latching, self-closing, lockable gate;
- Drowning contributes to unintentional injury-related death among children ages one to four;
- Children can drown in just a few centimetres of water, if it covers their mouth and nose.

### Lawn and garden tools

- Keep young children away from outdoor power equipment. Serious burns may result from touching hot engine surfaces;
- Ensure that all tools, fuel, chemicals, and other hazardous substances are stored in a secure, locked area. A simple latch may not be sufficient.

### Insect bites and stings

- Minimize the risk of attracting insects by not wearing strong perfumes or scented lotions;
- Avoid wearing brightly coloured clothing outdoors;
- Consider destroying, or re-locating hives and nests situated near your home;
- To avoid a bite in case of accidentally stepping on a stinging insect ensure your child wears shoes, or sandals;
- If your child has received an 'EpiPen Jr' prescription from your physician (for serious anaphylactic emergencies only) ensure they understand when and how to use it;
- If your child experiences a severe reaction to an insect sting, seek medical attention, or call 9-1-1.
